## WASTEWATER:

The City has advertised for the **RFP on the Membrane** procurement for the upgrade on the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

City Engineer Stack and I are working on the scope of work for an **Infiltration and Inflow Study** that needs to be completed this year in response to National Discharge Pollution Elimination Permit, section S4.E.2 with a report sent to Dept. of Ecology.

## STREETS:

**Sultan Basin Road** in Timber Ridge Development area has the first lift of asphalt in place.

**Dedication of Sultan Basin Road** US 2 realignment project "**Wold Corner**" is February 23 @ 11 AM. At the intersection we will be dedicating Phase 1 & 2 and Introduction Phase 3 which includes accepting one million dollars from Puget Sound Regional Council. The reception will follow at the City Hall.

As many of you are aware, you as well as City Hall receive many calls regarding, **grading of streets, sweeping of streets and vector truck activities**, here is a **soft schedule**:

Sweeping Streets	First week of every month
Grading (gravel)Streets	Around the 15 <sup>th</sup> of every month
Vector Truck Activities	I am working with Cuz Concrete on a quarterly schedule for vacuuming of storm and sewer.

Teresa Knuckey has volunteered to head up this group and has asked for City participation, we will be purchasing yellow garbage bags and the garbage crew will pick up these identifiable sacks with regular curb-side garbage service at no charge.

## STORMWATER:

The first meeting of the **Storm Water Utility Formation Advisory Group** is February 20<sup>th</sup> @ 6 PM, members include Sarah Davenport-Smith, Jeffrey Beeler, Brian Copple, Bob Gilmore, Deborah Knight and myself. Council members are invited to participate. The group will have approximately five meetings in addition to participation in the Open House on March 13, 2007 and other Public Meetings.

## GARBAGE:

**Clean up Day** is set for **April 21<sup>st</sup>**, it will include curbside chipping on the same day.

**PARKS:**

**Siren Pole** was moved on Friday, February 16, 2007 by Potelco in coordination with Snohomish County PUD with disconnecting and reconnection the power. We also obtained a Washington State Labor and Industry Electrical Permit # 1383504P.
