Before and After School (grades 1-5): \$200/month  
Before OR After School Only (grades 1-5): \$100/month  
Before and after Kindergarten: \$350/month for students bringing their own lunch, \$400/month if you wish lunch to be provided.

Annual \$20 Boys & Girls Club Membership is required.
