INTRODUCTION:

Chris Jury is the Youth Empowerment Coordinator and Project Assistant for the Snohomish County Health and Safety Network. The East County Youth Council based in Sultan is one of five youth councils that Chris facilitates throughout the county.

The East Youth Council has completed invaluable work for the community including cleanup of Osprey Park and Trails, the Four Lanes section of US 2 and the adoption of the Turk Trail between the High School and High Avenue. Over the past winter, the group organized a canned food drive at Sultan Schools generating over 600 items for the Sultan Food Bank.

This summer, the youth group will be installing two trash receptacles at the ends of Turk Trail while continuing to help maintain the trail by picking up trash and placing the bags from the receptacles on High Avenue for Tuesday Garbage pick up.

The youth group is continuing to work for the betterment of the community, making Sultan a better and healthier place to live. Scheduled in the month of June is another recon of the four lane area of US 2.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The garbage the East Youth Council picks up around the City on their many projects Public Works Garbage crew picks up with the truck and disposes on regular garbage days.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Recognize the volunteer work these young people and their friends under the leadership of Chris Jury, Youth Empowerment Coordinator and Project Assistant Snohomish County Health and Safety Network have completed and continue for the betterment of the City of Sultan.
