SUBJECT: Coordinated Prevention Grant (CPG) Application

ISSUES:

The issue before the City Council is to authorize staff to apply to the Department of Ecology for a Coordination Prevention Grant of Solid Waste and Recycling that funds Sultan's annual Clean up Day in mid-April.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the staff to apply for the CPG to help fund Sultan's annual clean up day.

SUMMARY:

The Washington State Department of Ecology offers a grant program for the prevention of solid waste and recycling building up on private property by providing grant funds that communities can apply for to help fund "Clean up Day" events. Applications for next year's event are due to the Department of Ecology on September 4, 2007.

The City of Sultan has applied for and received this grant to help fund Spring Cleanup for the last 10 years.

This year's event was April 21st and was considered successful. According to staff present the following items were collection:

236 truck loads of debris was collection

38 computer parts @ \$15 each = \$570.00

17 tv's @ \$20 each = \$340.00

6 big screen tv's @ \$30.00 = \$180.00

7 frig/freezers @ \$30.00 each = \$210.00

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City of Sultan will provide the 25% match which is covered by the in-kind work contribution of City staff and equipment.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Authorize Donna Murphy to complete the application for CPG funding with the 25% in-kind amount being the match for the grant, upon completion of the application the Mayor will review and sign.
