SUBJECT: Approval of Resolution 08-20 designating the Sultan Summer Shindig as a Community Event and prohibiting specified activities in the designated areas.

ISSUE:

The issue before the Council is the adoption of Resolution 08-20 to Co-sponsor the Sultan Summer Shindig with the Sky Valley Chamber of Commerce, waive applicable permit fees and prohibit specified activities in the event area.

SUMMARY:

This year will be the 25th Anniversary of the Sultan Summer Shindig. The event features a unique logging show, car show, a carnival, parades, live music and family entertainment. The City and Sky Valley Chamber have always partnered in the event. The Sky Valley Chamber Shindig Committee organizes the different events and coordinates with the Police and Public Works Departments. The expenses for the event and all required Health permits and L & I inspection costs are paid by the Sky Valley Chamber. Funds are contributed to the City to pay for the cost of Police overtime.

As a City sponsored event, there is no fee for the use of the City Park. The Sky Valley Chamber of Commerce requests that the City waive any other fees for special events permits, sign permits or right of way permits.

The attached Resolution establishes the Sultan Summer Shindig as a Community Event this year on July 11, 12 and 13 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. The Resolution also prohibits dogs, other pets, or other domestic animals from entering the area, and prohibits event attendees from riding bicycles, skateboards, and scooters on the property designated for the Shindig.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Loss of approximately \$235 in fee revenues.

2. Sandwich Sign fee of \$10
3. Banner Sign fee of \$75
4. Sign Deposit fee of \$50

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SULTAN DESIGNATING THE "SULTAN SUMMER SHINDIG" AS A COMMUNITY EVENT CO-SPONSORED BY THE CITY AND THE SKY VALLEY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, WAIVING APPLICABLE FEES AND PROHIBITING DOGS, OTHER PETS, OR OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND BICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS AND SCOOTERS FROM DESIGNATED AREAS WHERE THE "SULTAN SUMMER SHINDIG" WILL BE CONDUCTED

WHEREAS, the City of Sultan and Sky Valley Chamber of Commerce have co-sponsored the Sultan Summer Shindig for the past 25 years, and

WHEREAS, the Sky Valley Chamber of Commerce is responsible for the majority of the costs associated with the event, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sultan designates the "Sultan Summer Shindig" as a Community Event to be held on July 11, 12, and 13, 2008 between the hours of 7 AM and 1AM the following mornings; and

WHEREAS, the cost to the City is minimal staff time, however, the benefit to the City is having the local citizens and travelers spend money in town; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and the Sky Valley Chamber "Sultan Summer Shindig" committee desire to protect the visitors and participants of the Sultan Summer Shindig from dogs, other pets or other domestic animals and bicycle, skateboard and scooter riders within the designated areas where the Sultan Shindig will be conducted which is described on Exhibit A;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SULTAN:

1. The City Council hereby designates the "Sultan Summer Shindig" as a Community Event, which will be held on July 11, 12 and 13, 2008 between the hours of 7 AM and 1AM the following mornings within the area designated on "Exhibit A".
2. The City Council hereby prohibits Dogs, Pets, or Domestic animals to stray or enter within the area designated on "Exhibit A" as provided for in, SMC Chapter 6.04, and Section 6.04.032.
3. The City Council hereby prohibits the riding of Bicycles, Skateboards, and Scooters within the area designated on "Exhibit A" as provided for in SMC Chapter 12.25.
4. The City Council will waive all fees for signs, special events and use of the City park.
