<p><u>Vactor Truck Grant</u> – Working closely with Snohomish County to provide Citywide Vacor Service in Januray 2009.</p>	<p><u>Village at Sultan Crossing</u> – Developer paid the cost of vacation of Sultan Basin Road and the City is completing the deed for the developer. Developer needs to complete a Boundary Line Adjustment.</p>
<p><u>Sultan Boys and Girls Club Improvements</u> – The City of Sultan partnered with the Snohomish County Boys and Girls Club for a grant to CDBG for a new roof and building improvements to both buildings at the Sultan Boys and Girls Club. CDBG approved \$120,000</p>	<p><u>Koppenberg Enterprises</u> – Specializes in Architectural Columbarium Niches. Moved to Sultan (from Monroe) in November 1, 2008. <p><u>\$500,000 Legislative Earmark for WWTP</u> – These funds are secure and will become available when the City of Sultan’s Comprehensive Plan is in compliance.</p>	<p><u>Business Workshops</u> – Working with Mayor Eslick to provide valuable and educational information to Sultan business owners on a quarterly basis.</p>
<p><u>\$117,000 COPS Technology Grant</u> – Project is on schedule. Funding for 10 permanent surveillance cameras, 2 portable cameras with monitors at the police station, and 5 in car computers.
