

Notable Events During November 2009


- The City of Sultan, Sultan Fire, School District and Police Department again completed our Annual Evacuation Drill from our three schools in town and I understand it was completed in record time with fewer aid calls than normal. Department of Emergency Management also provided the Mobile Command Post for the event.
- On November 18th about 25 Block Watch members attended our monthly meeting and heard from Juvenile Probation Officer Ron Carr, who is an instructor on gang intervention and profiles.
- We worked with Rocky Walker and several high school kids to fill seven pallets of sandbags.
- The Sultan Police Department had several weapons the City Council surplus earlier this year. The bid process for those weapons was completed this month and Sultan will receive \$4,100 for the weapons from Kesslering's Gun Shop.
- The liquor store and Chinese restaurant were burglarized on November 12th and only liquor was taken from the one store. On the 13th the suspect returned to the liquor store and this time a canine unit was able to track the suspect to a house on High Street. The burglar was arrested, along with a second suspect that had violated a protection order earlier in the night. Deputies returned to the same house the next night to arrest yet another male for several warrants totaling \$22,000.
- You will notice that "Thefts" have taken quite a jump this year and have been spread throughout the city. The majority of these thefts have been "vehicle prowls" in which generally the suspects are entering unlocked cars at night and stealing small items. We have stepped up patrols and are asking our Block Watch members for help.

The following charts compare selected statistics in the reporting month to the same month in the previous year and provide the current year to date monthly average (YTD Average) totals for each category. These statistics were selected from more than 100 categories. All statistics may be reviewed by visiting Sultan City Hall.


Property Crimes Within Sultan City Limits
