
Notable Events During February 2010

- After months of work by staff, we received approval for our COPS Technology Grant Budget Revision so we are moving ahead with our camera project.
- Sultan Deputies received training on the two new portable cameras from our grant and are ready to deploy them.
- Shift rotation took place on February 1st at which time Scott Berg transferred to the North Precinct and Deputy Ian Whipple transferred to Sultan night shift.
- Terry Becker was selected as one of our two new Crime Analysis Detectives and transferred from Sultan School Resource Officer on February 1st. Deputy Tom Dittoe was selected to replace Terry and is now working as our SRO.
- On February 11th we had our first ever all city employee meeting so staff could meet each other and talk about city issues. Mayor Eslick and our City Council were also able to meet the staff and swear in all of our deputies.
- On February 12th Snohomish County Department of Emergency Management began teaching the six week Citizen Emergency Response Team (CERT) Training Program to about 30 Sultan and East County residents.
- On February 24th we had a combined Block Watch Meeting and Snohomish County All Hazards Mitigation Open House at Sultan Middle School. About 35 people attended the meeting to learn about the multi agency report and program.
- Early in February Deputy Lucas Robinson began investigating a possible murder for hire incident. After extensive investigation, detectives arrested one Sultan man for solicitation to commit murder. It has been determined the potential victim is not in danger currently so the investigation is continuing.
- Department of Corrections Lieutenant and local resident Bruce Ramsey was killed in a car vs motorcycle accident at Rice Road and U.S. 2. On February 17, 2010.




Property Crimes Within Sultan City Limits
