

### Transportation 2040 – The region's new transportation plan

- Extends the planning horizon to 2040 (same as **VISION 2040**)
- Aligns with **VISION 2040** and the **Regional Economic Strategy**
- **Current work:** Final Draft Plan is complete and scheduled for General Assembly adoption May 20, 2010

- **Key decision points:**
  - January 22, 2009 – Approved of the plan alternatives to be evaluated in the draft EIS
  - May 29, 2009 – Draft EIS released for public comment
  - July 31, 2009 – Comment period ends
  - August 31, 2009 - Preliminary Preferred Alternative (PPA) selected by Regional Staff Committee and Transportation 2040 Working Group & Pricing Task Force, and reviewed by PSRC Transportation Policy Board.
  - October 8, 2009 – Transportation Policy Board reviewed analysis results for the Preliminary Preferred Alternative, and instructed PSRC staff to make changes for the second round of analysis.   - October 22, 2009 – Completed Public Opinion Survey on transportation issue. Results can be found at <http://www.psrc.org/about/news/2009/10/23/transportation-2040-survey-results/>
  - November 12, 2009 – Transportation Policy Board reviewed the second round analysis and made a Preferred Alternative recommendation to the Executive Board for action on December 3.
  - December 3, 2009 – Executive Board approved Preferred Alternative and directed staff to release Draft Plan for review.
  - January 22, 2010 - Draft Plan released for public review. The Draft Plan can be found on the PSRC web site at <http://www.psrc.org/transportation/t2040/t2040-pubs/draft-transportation-2040>.
  - March 19, 2010 – Release of the Final EIS
  - March 25, 2010 – Executive Board recommended Final Plan for adoption by General Assembly
  - May 20, 2010 – Adoption of Plan by the General Assembly
