SUBJECT: Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) Grant Program

ISSUE: The issue before the Council is to discuss four (4) possible grant applications to Transportation Improvement Board:

1. Road Construction of a TIB classified arterial road or street
 - a. Preferred: Reclassification of Alder Avenue as an eligible arterial
 - b. If Alder Avenue is determined non-eligible, apply for reconstruction of 3rd Street from Main Street to High Avenue
2. Sidewalk construction on the west side of 1st Street from High Avenue to Willow Avenue
3. Sidewalk Maintenance – 2nd Street, phase II – from Birch Avenue to Date Avenue
4. Preservation Overlay and Chip Seal of Main Street from 1st Street to 8th Street

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Direct staff to apply to TIB for four (4) TIB grant applications:

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SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Transportation Improvement Board has called for projects for the TIB 2011 Grant Program. The application is due August 31, 2010.

The critical criteria for road and street eligibility are, the project must meet one of the following conditions to qualify as an arterial and hence, eligible for TIB construction funds:

1. Serve as a logical extension of a county arterial or state highway into the corporate limits
2. Serve as a route connecting local generators such as schools, medical facilities, social centers, recreational areas, commercial areas and industrial sites
3. Act as a bypass or truck route to relieve the central core area

ALTERNATIVES:

1. Apply for one or all of the staff recommended TIB grant applications
2. Do not apply for TIB grants for the 2011 funding cycle.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

Road Construction projects, up to \$500,000:	5% Match
Sidewalk Construction projects, up to \$100,000:	5% Match
Preservation Overlay and Chip Seal projects, up to \$100,000:	No match requirement if the City's valuation is under \$100 million
