

Notable Events of June 2010

-  You will note there were 10 burglaries during the month of June, including two of vacant buildings, one that was determined to be civil and another which an arrest was made. We continue to follow up on the other cases.
-  We spent quite a bit of time looking for a local resident who had a U.S. Marshal's Federal warrant and had Marshals and other police agencies looking for him throughout the valley.
-  We purchased the last of the COPS Technology equipment, including camera, laptops and other equipment.
-  Our JAG Grant was ending at the end of this month so we used some JAG money to purchase reflective vests for our Block Watchers and folders for our Block Watch and others to store crime prevention information.
-  The Association of Washington Cities insurance carrier brought their fire arms video trailer to Sultan and all of the Sultan Deputies and many of the East County Deputies were able to practice shoot / don't shoot scenarios.
-  Our new Secretary Sandy was off work for medical procedures and was back filed by South Precinct Secretary Carol Bello. Sandy is back to work in light duty status now.


