PERSONNEL:

For 2010, the public works department had 2 part-time seasonal workers:

Denny Johansen worked from April 8 through October 8, 2010.

Jeff Van Wyngarden worked from May 17 through August 11, 2010.

CAPITAL PROJECTS:

- ❖ Light guard crossing at 3rd Street and High Avenue
 - Completed in 2010.

- ❖ Hypochlorite Conversion at the Water Treatment Plant
 - Completed August, 2010.

- ❖ South Sultan Basin Rd.
 - Right of Way acquisition started.
 - Continuing with this project into 2011.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT:

- ❖ 2010 has been a year of repairing and replacing pumps and motors at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. The following list reflects 2010:
 - Replaced lift station pumps, motors, and volutes
 - Rebuilt the motor and the upper and lower bearings on one of the Archimedes screw pumps
 - Rebuilt the gear box and replaced the motor on one Mammoth Rotary Mixer
 - Replaced bearings in Clarifier # 2 gearbox
 - Replaced Variable Frequency Drive (VFD) on both Mammoth Rotary Mixers.

STREETS:

- ❖ Projects completed in 2010
 - Chip Seal of 8th Street.
 - Paving of 140th Street SE.
 - Painting of City crosswalks completed by Crosswater and LDS Churches.

STORMWATER:

- ❖ Snohomish County, Bravo Environmental and Sultan Public Works cleaned 412 catch basins in the City this year.

- ❖ Staff held a Storm Water Stakeholders meeting in September presenting the 2010 expenditures and accomplishments, and the proposed 2011 budget.
