The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has revised select maps that identify flood hazard zones within Snohomish County. Pending revisions reflect recent engineering studies and other updated information. The final maps will indicate where mortgage lenders may require flood insurance and where development regulations may apply. **Property owners are encouraged to review the revised flood maps.** Maps are available online at <http://snohomishcountywa.gov/201/Planning-Development-Services>. Paper maps are also available at Planning and Development Services, 2nd Floor Admin Building East, 3000 Rockefeller Ave, Everett, WA 98201. Property owners who believe mapping on their land is inaccurate may request changes to the maps. The process for requesting a map change will be discussed at the November 28th and December 12th open houses. **More information is available** by calling the FEMA Map Information eXchange (FMIX), 877.336.2627, or by visiting FEMA's Flood Map Service Center at msc.fema.gov.
