Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Sultan, until 3:00 pm on January 4, 2017 for the Grit Equipment Replacement project.

Work to be performed includes:

Replacement of the existing grit classifier, cyclone and associated equipment at the City of Sultan Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP).

Bid proposals will be received only at, City Hall, 319 Main Street Suite 200, Sultan, WA by 3:00 pm on January 4, 2017 at which time they will be opened, read, and tabulated publicly. **Proposals that are mailed must be addressed to PO Box 1199, Sultan, WA 98294.** Proposals received after the time fixed for opening will not be considered. A non-mandatory walkthrough will be held at the Sultan WWTP on December 14, 2016 at 11:00 am. The WWTP is located at 230 West Stevens Avenue, Sultan, WA.

Each bid proposal shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, postal money order, or surety bond in an amount equal to at least 5 percent of the amount of such bid proposal. Checks shall be made payable to the City of Sultan. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance and payment bond within the time stated in the Specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sultan.
