The Sultan Pedestrian and Bicycle Bridge project—the city graciously asks for your support



The Sultan Pedestrian and Bicycle Bridge project is one of 12 projects recommended for funding by the Puget Sound Regional Council through its Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP). The PSRC Executive Board is expected to approve the projects for funding on January 25, 2018. Over the past five years, community members have expressed overwhelming advocacy for the pedestrian bridge project, including numerous letters of support and hundreds of signatures that were sent to the legislature as the city sought construction funding. Utility rate increases reflected in January 2018 bill

The City recently hired a consultant to perform rate studies on water, sewer and storm water utilities. Rate studies are performed to assess and determine if the current / projected revenue will be sufficient to cover maintenance, operating and improvement expenses for that specific utility. The results of the study indicated that in order to sufficiently fund these utilities going forward, it would be necessary to adopt new rate schedules for all three utilities. The resulting rate increases are effective December 1, 2017, and reflected on your January, 2018 billing statement.
