On Thursday, January 25, 2018, the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) Executive Board voted unanimously in favor of funding the Sultan Pedestrian and Bicycle Bridge project. The project, which will receive \$2.5 million in construction funding through the PSRC's Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP), was eligible for the award based on criteria outlined in the TAP's "Bicycle and Pedestrian" category. The city of Sultan was one of 12 agencies recommended for funding, out of a total of 64 applications.
