## All-ages 3 on 3 Basketball Tournament Saturday August 5!

The Sultan Community Alliance and Sultan Youth Basketball are teaming up to bring Sultan Swoosh, a brand new 3-on-3 basketball tournament on Saturday, August 5! Sultan Swoosh is an all-ages tournament that takes place at the corner of First and Main Street, near Sultan's River Park. The tournament kicks off at 9 a.m. on Saturday, August 5, 2017, with check-in available from 7:30 to 8:30 a.m. on the morning of the event. This family-friendly tournament is open to the entire Snohomish County region and beyond! Those not participating on teams are invited to come and root for their favorite players as Sultan's downtown area is transformed into a live sports arena.

Pre-registration is required.

Four-person teams are organized by grade level from third through eighth grade, and by skill level at the high school and adult levels. An entry fee of \$80 (FOUR-PERSON TEAMS, \$20 PER PLAYER) applies to teams eighth-grade and under, while registration for high school and adult teams is \$100 per team (FOUR-PERSON TEAMS, \$25 PER PLAYER).
