This is due to annexations that have occurred over the years, resulting in county property becoming incorporated into the city limits. The mixture of addresses creates issues within SNOPAC’s 911 emergency communication system that could lead to delayed response times. We want your children to be as safe as possible walking or biking to our school! Getting to school on foot or by bike is a great way for your kids to get exercise. They are ready to learn when they get to school this way. Sultan School District and Snohomish Health District worked together to make this map to show the safest way to school. Please follow the marked routes when your child walks or bikes to school. Everyone is safer when more kids are on the same route. Cars get used to seeing walkers and bikers, and your child can enjoy being with others from Sultan Elementary.



The main routes to Sultan are **Fir, Date, 8th and 4th**. Please use the shortest, safest way from your home to one of these streets. The map shows you how to get to these routes. One change this year is the school gate on 4th between Fir and Date is now closed. Please do NOT cross mid block on 4th as this is not a safe spot. Have your child walk to Date and 4th or Fir and 4th and cross there instead. Please visit the city website to view a detailed map.

We have included a legend to show what the symbols on the map mean. The symbols help you find crosswalks, crossing guards, and intersections with stop signs for traffic.
