# The 2017 Return of the Salmon Celebration

Saturday, Sept. 23 • Osprey Park • 10:30—4 pm



The City invites the community to the sixth annual Return of the Salmon Celebration at Osprey Park! Meant to honor Chief John T'seul-ted and celebrate the salmon that return each year to the City's local watersheds, the Return of the Salmon Celebration takes place 10:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 23, 2017 in the covered basketball courts at Osprey Park. The event includes the fourth annual 5-kilometer "Salmon Run," a timed runners' race that kicks off at 10:00 a.m. and offers a 1-mile fast walk.

The Return of the Salmon Celebration is a unique event that honors and shares Native American heritage, including a Native welcoming ceremony, drumming, a mini powwow, musical performances and Native storytelling. It offers an infusion of watershed education, with horse-drawn covered wagon rides to the Sultan High School salmon hatchery and riverside walking tours. Vendors on-site provide hand-made items, educational displays and arts and crafts for kids. The event is free to attend! This year's celebration features music and storytelling by JP Flacon Grady, Blackfeet, and Swil Kanim, Lummi, both brand new to the event.

Salmon, pulled pork and lemonade will be available for purchase from Vick's Burger Shack.

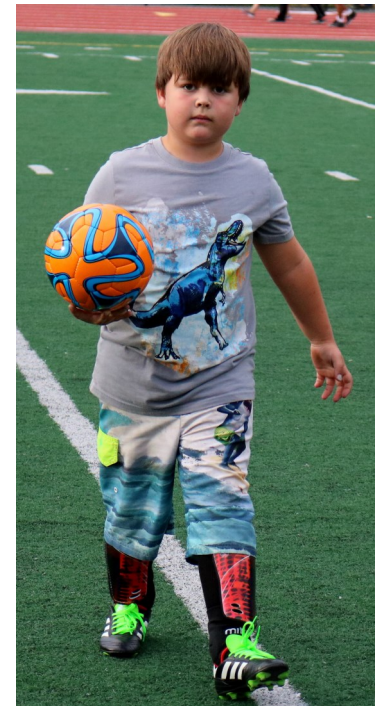
The Sultan Education Foundation (SEF) will provide grilled hot dogs during the event. Families and guests are encouraged to bring a side dish to share.
