Disposable wipes are NOT flushable!

Please keep baby wipes and other pre-moistened sanitary products out of the city's sewer system! Inaccurately touted as "flushable," disposable wipes and similar-style products cause severe problems at the city's wastewater treatment plant, including clogged pumps. These clogs are costly, as they necessitate emergency repairs by city maintenance staff. Every time a clog occurs, the plant is forced to shut down as our operators remove these disposable rags by hand. Thank you for keeping these products out of the sewer system!

Fats, oils and grease, oh my!

When poured down the drain and into your garbage disposal, fats, oils and grease (FOG) have a detrimental effect on the sewer system. A buildup of fats, oils and grease will accumulate in the pipes, leading to costly backups and sewage overflows. Sources of FOG include cooking oil, butter, lard, milk, cream, mayonnaise, food scraps and more.

PLEASE pour cooled fats, oils and grease into a covered container that can be thrown into the garbage, and use compost and garbage to dispose of food scraps. Help us save our pipes!

Congratulations to 39th District Rep. Carolyn Eslick!

After nearly a decade at the city's helm, Washington State Representative Carolyn Eslick will resign her position as mayor. Appointed to fill the vacancy left by 39th District Representative John Koster, Eslick was sworn in on Wednesday, Sept. 20, 2017. She earned the new job after a competitive process that involved extensive vetting by 39th District Republican Precinct Committee Officers, the Snohomish County Council, the King County Council and the Skagit County Commission. Eslick plans to resign her position as mayor at the end of October, at which point she will hand city leadership over to the current mayor pro tem, Councilmember John Seehuus.

Seehuus will serve as mayor until the Sultan City Council moves to appoint one of its seven members to fill Eslick's vacancy. The council has 90 days in which to appoint a new mayor.

Properties within Sultan city limits are identified by a combination of county and city-generated addresses. This is due to annexations that have occurred over the years, resulting in county property becoming incorporated into the city limits. The mixture of addresses creates issues within SNOPAC's 911 emergency communication system that could lead to delayed response times.
