Representative Eslick passes the torch to Mayor John Seehuus

Longtime Sultan Mayor Carolyn Eslick has handed city leadership over to former Councilmember and Mayor Pro Tem John Seehuus, after nearly a decade at the city's helm.

Eslick's resignation comes on the heels of her recent appointment to the Washington State Legislature, where she will serve as the 39th District Representative. Eslick, who was sworn in as state representative on Wednesday, Sept. 20, resigned her position as mayor on Tuesday, October 31, 2017. Mayor Seehuus will serve in the top position until the Sultan City Council moves to appoint one of its seven members to fill Eslick's vacancy. Five councilmembers are interested, including Seehuus.

"It is a tremendous honor to serve as mayor," Seehuus said. "I am excited about my expanded role and welcome ideas from the community."

Effective immediately: NO PARKING IN CUL-DE-SACS

City cul-de-sacs are no parking zones. Parking in cul-de-sacs inhibits the access of emergency vehicles, which require adequate space to swiftly navigate city roadways in the course of an emergency incident. Residents will notice signs in accordance with the new regulations. The city is offering a three-month grace period in which fines will be waived and warnings will be issued. The grace period is in effect as of November 1, 2017.

15 MINUTE PARKING IN SCHOOL ZONE

A 15-minute load/unload zone is in effect Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. on the east and west side of 4th Street near the elementary school. There is an additional 15-minute zone on the north side of Date Avenue from 4th Street to east of the school driveway.

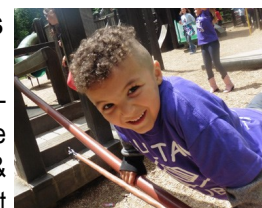
Sultan Harvest
